

PUT YOUR ARMOR ON EVERY DAY WHEN YOU WAKE UP VIA EPHESIANS 6:

* Strengthen me with power through Your Spirit in my inner man, that I would stand firm in all circumstances and take up the full armor of God to be able to stand in the evil day. Fill me up to all the fullness of You. (*Ephesians 3:16-17, 19, 6:13*)

* Lord, I put on the belt of [Your] truth and the breastplate of Your righteousness [given me through Christ.] I put on my feet the preparation of the Gospel of peace, and take up the shield of faith so that all fiery darts of the enemy would be extinguished. I put on my head the helmet of salvation, and take the sword of the Spirit - the Word of God itself. (*Ephesians 6:14-17*)

Jesus, in You I stand firm. Fill me with Your Spirit and let me live by the Spirit, walking in step with You every moment.

THE LORD'S PRAYER (MATTHEW 6:9-13):

*"Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.
Your kingdom come, Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
[For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.]"*

* Also pray these prayers daily for others.

MORE DAILY PRAYERS:

* Create a pure heart in me, and a steadfast and willing spirit. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation. Search my heart and reveal to me anything I need to repent of. Cleanse me of all sin and led me in being more like Jesus by the power of Your Spirit. (*Psalms 51:10-12, Psalm 139:22-24*)

* God, remove anything in me that is not of You, and fill me with Your desires [as I delight and trust in You.] Give me discernment to know what is of You and what is not. (*Psalms 37:4*)

* God, fill me continually with Your Spirit and keep me in sync with You. Let me live by Your Spirit, sowing to the Spirit and not to the flesh. (*Galatians 5:16, 25*)

* God, let me know Your heart, and let me live in rhythm with Your heartbeat and in tune with Your Spirit.

* Teach me and guide me into all Your truth by Your Holy Spirit. Holy Spirit, tell me what's on Your heart and guide me to pray as You lead. (*John 16:13-15*)

* God, let Your joy be my strength. Help me abide in You and bear much fruit of Your Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control). (*Nehemiah 8:10, Galatians 5:22-23*)

* God, give me a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of You and who I am in Christ. Let me know Your love deeply and be firmly rooted in Your love and know the riches of my inheritance in You. (*Ephesians 1:17-18, Ephesians 3:17-18*)

* Lord, give me wisdom, understanding, knowledge, discretion and clarity and help me to use them according to Your purposes. Give me clear discernment and help me to use it according to Your will. (*mostly via Proverbs*)

* God, bind my mind to the mind of Christ. Let my soul [mind, will, emotions] and body be governed by Your Holy Spirit. Fix all of me fully on Jesus at all times, seeking You, Your Kingdom and righteousness first. Let me love You with all of me and above all else. (*Psalms 45:10-11; Colossians 2:5 Amplified; Psalm 57:7; Matthew 6:33*)

* God, help me to love others and myself as You love. Give me a servant's heart and equip me continually to do Your will for Your Kingdom purposes. Help me to do justly, love kindness and mercy, and walk humbly with You. (*Micah 6:8*) Use me as a vessel for Your glory.

* Lord, make me beautiful for You and Your glory, beautiful inside, living in the purity and simplicity of wholehearted devotion to You. (*2 Corinthians 11:3*)

* Jesus, as the Author and Perfecter of faith, give me even more faith, and perfect and strengthen the faith You've given me. Let me fix my eyes on You, and be confident in You alone. (*Hebrews 12:2*)

* Help me to encourage and edify others in You, Lord. Let me think, speak and do what brings life, love, truth and encouragement. (*Ephesians 4:29*)

* Lord, You have not given me a spirit of fear or timidity. Give me a spirit of power, love, sound mind and discipline in You. Help me not to neglect the gifts that You've given me, and equip me in them for Your purposes. (*2 Timothy 1:7, 1 Timothy 4:14-15*)

* Lord, help me to live worthy of Your calling, with humility, gentleness, patience and love. (*Ephesians 4:1-2*)
